

American Indian Resources

In the past, American Indians fished, hunted and grew crops for food. They made clothing from animal skins and plants. They constructed shelters from resources found in their environment (sod, stones, animal skins, wood).

| Type of resource: | Other examples: |
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| Natural Resources: Things that come directly from nature. Ex.: wild animals | lumber (wood), stones, crops |
| Human Resources: People working to produce goods and services. Ex.: Farmers | hunters, animal keepers, fishermen |
| Capital Resources: Goods produced and used to make other goods and services. Ex.: canoes | tools, weapons, medicine • bow/arrow • spear |
